**2008/2009 BEAR VALLEY MOUNTAIN RESORT SEASON PASS TERMS,
EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE, INDEMNIFICATION AND COVENANT NOT TO SUE AGREEMENT
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING**

In consideration for receipt of a Bear Valley Mountain Resort ("BVMR") Season Pass and permission to use the facilities of the snow sports area, I, on behalf of myself, as parent or guardian of the minor child listed below, and our heirs and assigns, understand and agree to all of the following (constituting the "Agreement"):

1. "Skier" means any person who is within the boundaries of a ski area for the purpose of engaging in, or observing, the sport of skiing, including but not limited to alpine or nordic, and without regard to the type of skiing device used, such as dual skis, snowboard, or any other type of skiing device.
 2. Season Passes are NON-TRANSFERABLE. Fraudulent use or violation of any area policy may result in pass cancellation without refund. Violations of any federal, state or local ordinances while on BVMR property similarly may result in Season Pass cancellation without refund. In the event my season pass is lost or stolen, I must immediately report it to the main office. **There will be a NON-REFUNDABLE reinstatement processing charge of \$50.00 for Adult and Teen and \$25.00 for all others.** If I find my lost pass, I must immediately notify BVMR, and return the pass to the main office. If I forget my pass for the day, I understand I can buy a \$5 replacement ticket for that day. BVMR Season Passes are not refundable under any circumstances, including but not limited to: no snow, didn't like the snow we got, never used the Pass, injury, surgery, planned or unplanned pregnancy, broken bones, financial hardship, moving out of state, moving out of country, traveling, going to school, changed my mind, incarceration, better offer came along, sudden dislike for Bear Valley or their staff, sickness, terminal illness, mental breakdown, divorce, death or scanning.

 3. Pass holders injured during the snow sports season, resulting in the inability to complete the season, may have the remaining value of their pass prorated, less a processing fee, with the balance carried over to their season pass for the following season. Pass must be returned at time of injury to the main office. Written verification of the injury by a licensed physician is required.
 4. I understand and am aware that skiing, snowboarding and other snow sports activities (referred to herein as "Activities") are HAZARDOUS ACTIVITIES involving INHERENT AND OTHER RISKS of injury to any and all parts of my body. These risks include, but are not limited to: variations in snow and terrain, ice and icy conditions, moguls, rocks, trees, and other forms of forest growth or debris (above and below the surface), bare spots, lift towers, cables, utility lines, snowmaking equipment and component parts, and other forms of natural or man-made obstacles. There also is a risk of collisions with such obstacles, equipment and natural objects as well as with other skiers, snowboarders, and/or other participants in Activities at Bear Valley Mountain Resort. I further understand that injuries in the Activities are a COMMON AND ORDINARY OCCURRENCE, and I freely ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL RISKS OF INJURY OR DEATH as a result of my participation in the Activities at Bear Valley Mountain Resort.
 5. ALPINE COUNTY SKIER SAFETY ORDINANCE # 562-94 – Pass holder must obey the SKIER SAFETY CODE for Alpine County. The CODE describes each skier's many duties and responsibilities and is important to all members of the skiing public. Violators of the CODE may be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
WARNING: Under the Alpine County Code, a skier assumes the inherent risk and dangers of skiing including but not limited to: changing weather conditions; existing and changing snow conditions; variations in terrain, bare spots; rocks; stumps; trees; cliffs; extreme terrain; collisions with natural objects, under growth, man-made objects, freestyle terrain, jumps, or other skiers; variation in terrain; and the failure of skiers to ski within their own abilities.
- Under the CODE, you cannot board a lift unless you have sufficient ability to use such lift, and skiers shall follow any written or verbal instructions that they are given by the ski area operator or its representative regarding the use of the lifts.
6. To the fullest extent allowed by law, I agree to RELEASE LIABILITY, INDEMNIFY AND HOLD HARMLESS BVMR, their owners, officers, agents, employees, and all other persons or entities officially connected with BVMR with regard to any and all liability on account of, or in any way resulting from, personal injuries, death or property damage, even if caused by NEGLIGENCE of BVMR, in any way connected with my participation in Activities at BVMR. I further AGREE NOT TO MAKE A CLAIM OR SUE FOR INJURIES OR DAMAGES in any way connected with my participation in the Activities and agree not to make a claim or sue for injuries or damages. This liability release and agreement not to sue also applies to any loss or injuries that result from personal injuries, death, or property damage related to my use of any ski lifts or other equipment at BVMR. I understand that BVMR is not responsible for any damage to equipment or clothing, including grease stains, as a result of participating in snow sports or use of facilities.
 7. I understand and agree that this Agreement is governed by and intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by California law. If any portion is held invalid, pursuant to California law, the balance shall continue in full legal force and effect. I agree that no oral representations, statements or inducements apart from this Agreement have been made.
 8. I will observe and obey posted signs. I will keep out of all "Closed Areas". I will ski only within the BVMR Area Boundaries. If I ski out of bounds, I assume all risks inherent in backcountry skiing, including cost of Search and Rescue. I understand that violating any safety rule will not only result in the immediate loss of all privileges and use of the facilities of BVMR (without compensation), but will also subject me to the following State of California Penal Records, #6531 and #602(q) stated; Any person involved in a skiing accident who leaves the accident scene may be subject to a \$1000 fine- (P.C. 653i). Any person skiing within or entering into a CLOSED AREA may be subject to criminal prosecution, which could result in a \$1000 fine and 6 months in jail- (P.C. 602(q)).
 9. I agree to present my Season Pass for each lift ride. I agree to surrender my Season Pass if asked by any member of the Bear Valley Professional Ski Patrol or BVMR Management.
 10. In regards to the Mountain/Meadow Combo Pass and any and all activities performed at Bear Valley Cross Country ("BVCC"), I understand that BVMR acts solely in the capacity of payment administrative agent for BVCC, a company unrelated to BVMR, and BVMR assumes no liability whatsoever for any activities related to and/or performed at BVCC, including, but not limited to, cross-country skiing and snowshoeing.
 11. I understand that any dispute regarding the enforceability of this Agreement shall be filled in the courts of Alpine County, State of California, and shall not be transferred to any other state.

I HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE THAT I, AND ALL MINORS LISTED ON THE FRONT OF THIS FORM, HAVE FULLY READ, UNDERSTAND AND ACCEPTED EACH OF THE ABOVE PROVISIONS, AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNED THIS AGREEMENT.
